State Bank of India (SBI) on Tuesday surpassed ONGC to become the country's most valued state-owned firm in terms of market valuation. At end of trade, the market cap of SBI was ₹2,35,307.51 crore. This was about ₹2,961.79 crore more than ONGC's ₹2,32,345.72 crore. ONGC once used to be the country's most-valued company in terms of market valuation. Among the top-10 most valued companies list, SBI is at fifth position. PTI

Bank funding in REITs, InvITs capped at 10%
MUMBAI Banks may not invest more than 10% of unit capital of Real Estate Investment Trusts (REITs) and Infrastructure Investment Trusts (InvITs), the RBI said on Tuesday. During the first bimonthly policy review of 2017-18, the central bank allowed banks to invest in such funds, within the overall ceiling of 20% permitted for direct investments in capital markets (including venture capital funds).

Anti-dumping duty likely on hydrogen peroxide
NEW DELHI India may impose anti-dumping duty of up to \$118 per tonne on import of a chemical used by industries in applications such as corrosion control and paper bleaching from six countries. The move is aimed at guarding domestic players from cheap imports of 'hydrogen peroxide' from Bangladesh, Taiwan, Korea, Indonesia, Pakistan and Thailand. National Peroxide Ltd. and Hindustan Organic Chemicals Ltd. had jointly filed for the probe. PTI

Railways seek aid for unviable routes

Finance Ministry used to subsidise losses on operating strategic rail routes prior to merger of budgets

NEW DELHI The Railway Ministry has sought compensation for operating railway lines of strategic and national importance — a practice discontinued following the merger of Railway and Union Budgets.

“We have sent a proposal for approval of the Union Cabinet to reimburse operational losses on national projects, projects of national importance, uneconomic branch lines, border area projects and all strategic lines,” said a senior Railway Ministry official, on condition of anonymity.

The Railway Ministry's proposal has already faced opposition from the Finance Ministry, the official said.

Every year, the Indian Railways used to get subsidy from the Finance Ministry for losses incurred on railway operations on strategic lines. After the Budget merger, the Finance Ministry had

discontinued the practice of providing annual subsidy to the Railways for operating loss-making strategic routes as the Railways was no longer required to pay an annual dividend.

Recently, two Parliamentary bodies — Standing Committee on Railways and Estimates Committee — recommended that the Finance

Ministry should continue compensating the Railways for losses in operating strategic lines.

‘Nation-building’
“Considering the role of Railways in nation building, reimbursement to Railways on their operating losses on strategic lines is justifiable,” the Standing Committee on

Railways said in a report. The subsidy provided to the Indian Railways by Finance Ministry for non-profitable routes stood at ₹4,024 crore and ₹3,723 crore in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively. However, in 2016-17, the Railways had budgeted subsidy of ₹4,301 crore on unviable routes which it didn't receive from the Finance

Ministry as its annual dividend was waived off.

“As these lines mainly cater to defence movements on border areas and development of social and backward region, the Committee recommends that reimbursement of operational losses on strategic lines and railway lines in hilly, coastal and backward areas should be continued and desires the Ministry of Railways to pursue the matter with Ministry of Finance in this regard,” the committee added.

The panel felt that compensation helped the Railways in providing relief towards “socially desirable projects” which are usually loss-making projects.

The Estimates Committee, chaired by BJP veteran Murlu Manohar Joshi, in its report on Structural Changes in Union Budget had also said that the Railways should “continue to get reimbursement of losses on operation of strategic lines.”

Singapore Airlines to operate A350 to India

CHENNAI Singapore Airlines (SIA) plans to deploy Airbus A350 on India-Singapore sector later this year with a view to optimise the age of its existing fleet, a top official said. “We are expecting to bring the A350 to India later this year,” said David Lim, general manager, India, Singapore Airlines.

“This will replace the existing Boeing 777-200 and Airbus A330.” “While Airbus A350 has 253 seats, Boeing 777-200 has 270-280 seats. We are trying to replace them to keep our fleet as young as possible. The average age of

our fleet is seven years and eight months, said an airline spokesperson.

SIA currently has 12 A350 aircraft.

The Airbus A350 was deployed on the Singapore-San Francisco sector (non-stop service) in October 2016 and it had received overwhelming response.

Asked about the cities which these aircraft may connect, Mr. Lim said: “When we fly long routes, there would be some time in between. We are trying to use this time to fly to India. However, it is too early to say.” Currently, there were no plans to add more cities or flights, he added.

Berger plans joint ventures to enter new segments

Mulls facility through Polish arm for insulation coating

KOLKATA Berger Paints India Ltd. (BPIL) is planning to enter new product segments in automobile and marine paints through joint ventures with two Japanese companies, a top official said.

The company is also exploring opportunities to set up a facility for making insulation coating for constructing temperature-controlled buildings. This would be through its subsidiary Bolix, S A, Poland.

“We have finalised a JV with Rock Paints, Japan for making auto-refinish products (to be used for repairing damaged cars) and

another one with Chugoku Paint, also of Japan, for marine coatings,” said Abhijit Roy, managing director and chief executive officer.

These JVs are likely to be formed before 2017-18. BPIL, which has memoranda of understanding with these companies now, may have a controlling interest in the refinishing paint company. “It is a ₹2,000-crore market in India,” said Mr. Roy.

The two products had good growth rates in India and the market was dominated by foreign players.

SAIL adds rail capacity to retain key business

Banks on Universal Rail Mill for orders

CHENNAI Faced with the prospect of losing exclusivity in the supply of rails to the Indian Railways, the Steel Authority of India Ltd.'s Bhilai Steel Plant (BSP) has added a Universal Rail Mill (URM) as part of its effort to scale up capacity at BSP to 7 million tonnes of crude steel per annum.

“The URM, which has the capacity to produce 1.2 million tonnes of rails per annum, would help the company to meet the increasing demand of Indian Railways for more volume of 260-metre rails,” said Vijay Mairal, BSP's deputy general manager (public relations). “SAIL would be in a position to supply about 2 million tonnes of rails to the railways annually which will be the largest rail production capacity in any steel plant globally.”

The Indian Railways has invited global expressions of interest for the supply of rails as part of its plan to renovate the track network and improve operational safety. The vast state rail operator, which is undergoing a \$130 billion, five-year overhaul to modernise the world's fourth-largest network, is set to open up annual purchases worth up to \$700 million to the private sector, Reuters reported last month, citing sources.

Train accidents

Railway officials, who did not wish to be named, told *The Hindu* frequent rail fractures or weld failures that had resulted in train accidents had been a key factor that led the railways to call for open tenders to procure rails. In a note on accident mitigation measures sent to all zones, the Railway Board had noted that procurement

of superior quality of rails had to be expedited.

Responding to queries about the capacity of its steel plants and quality of rails in the backdrop of the railways floating global tenders to procure long welded rails, Mr. Mairal said BSP had commissioned a new Long Rail Welding complex. The 130-metre-long rail rolled at the URM was the world's longest rail in a single piece, he said.

The Railway Board had insisted that long rails should be deployed as a rule so as to minimise the number of in-situ welds which were more vulnerable.

“Deployment of 13-metre long rails is not desirable on the safety front,” a top railway official said. “We have been flagging this issue with the suppliers for over 8 years now. Since SAIL is the sole supplier, railways is left with no other option but to lay 13-metre-long rails. Of the 7,100-km of new lines, gauge conversion and relaying of old tracks announced by the Minister of Railways in the budget, only 25% per cent is being considered for long weld rails,” the official said. “Rail and weld fractures remain a perennial threat to safety of train operations and shifting to 130-metre or 260-metre weld rails” is the best option.
